





Who was Vaino Väljas?

Former Estonian Soviet politician and diplomat. On June 10, 1988 he was called from Latin America to Moscow, where the Secretary General of the Central Committee of Communist Party Mikhail Gorbachev announced to him that he should take up the post of the first secretary of the Central Committee in Estonia. After Karl Vaino removal of 16 June 1988 Vaino Väljas started his work in the Central Committee in Tallinn. Between 1988-1990 he led the Communist Party in Estonia and actively participated in the reforms and the Estonian independence movement.
