Short-term joint staff training event. Palermo, Italy, September 16-20, 2019

Partners presented and finalized curriculum and tested five learning modules for adult educators and senior citizens.

Module 1 - "Internet basics - what actually is the Internet?"

Module 2 - "How to stay on-line and be safe - paying, shopping, banking without fear" - including negative cases recorded as Digital Story Telling.

Module 3 - "How to responsibly share information and still keep it private" - including positive cases recorded as DST.

Module 4 - "Assessing learners skills and competences".

Module 5 - "Creating awareness on validation of the acquired competences".

Partners also discussed OER implementation and works on the Virtual Platform. Methodology of training seniors with the use of OER - program, exercises, evaluation tools – also was in agenda.



Work on Intellectual Output 1 "Digital Life" training course

Partners developed modules for "Digital Life" training course and translated them from English to the national languages – French, Italian, Greek, Estonian, Spanish and Polish. OER with customized "Digital Life" training course was tested with adult educators (20 from each partner's country). Now project materials can be used by seniors either during organised training or as self-administered learning.
